

Provision about contest «Culture for green planet»

1. International contest “Culture for green planet” (hereinafter referred to as Contest) is organized within the III Pan-European Festival Marathon “From the Atlantics to the Pacific Ocean” (www.fmarathon.com), hereinafter referred to as Marathon. Contest goal is to promote pieces of art created to support the environment, popularize ecological literacy, and provide additional opportunities to express oneself within a large international project for anyone who cares about preservation of man’s life environment.
2. Circle of the Contest participants is not limited. Any person can send only one piece of art and then he or she automatically becomes a participant of the Pan-European Festival Marathon.
3. If you want to participate in the Contest you need to register and fill in the Questionary. If you mention invalid data in the Questionary it may be a reason for denial in acceptance of your work and your work will be removed from the Contest.
4. Works for the Contest should be sent to the Organizer’s email address (fmarathon@inbox.ru) in a digital form from March, 1, 2017 to May, 1, 2017. Contest results will be announced by June, 1, 2017.
5. You can present the following works for the Contest:
 - picture\drawing
 - digital picture
 - photo
 - video
 - sculpture (installation)
 - text
6. Each work should comply with the main topic of the Contest.
7. Under a picture\drawing we assume an image made by hand with the help of a pencil, a brush, a pen or any other art mean. A work should be digitalized (high quality photo or scan).
8. Under a digital picture we assume an image totally made on computer with the use of different graphic programs.
9. Under a photo we assume a photo or a series of photos (not more than 10) executed in a form of slide show or presentation.

10. Under video we assume a film or an animated cartoon that you make yourself (record and edit). Film can be documental or story film, it shouldn't last longer than 5 minutes, it can be in Russian or in English or has titles in one of these two languages. Film should be uploaded into a hosting with public access (Youtube, Rutube, Vimeo etc.) and send Organizers a corresponding link.
11. Under sculpture (installation) we assume a self-made volumetric work, art composition, including one made of nature materials or materials that can be recycled or utilized. That work should be pictured from not less than 3 perspectives with statement of its scale size (you don't need to send to Organizers the work itself).
12. Under text we assume a poem or prose written in scientific, conversational, art or journalistic style. Volume – up to 5000 symbols in Russian or English or other language, but then with a translation into Russian or English.
13. Each piece of work should have a short annotation in Russian or English (up to 500 symbols), that reveals given topic (videos and texts don't have to be accompanied by annotation).
14. All works should be works of authorship, they shouldn't be published anywhere before (including social networks) and shouldn't participate in any other contests before March, 1, 2017. After the work is submitted to the contest participants have a right to place it in public space as they see fit.
15. After May, 1, 2017, Organizer will sum up the results in the named categories of works. The winners will be rewarded with certificates of honor and memorable gifts. Their names and photos will be published on the official website of the Marathon and in the special issue of the European Club magazine dedicated to the III Pan-European Festival Marathon.
16. Authors of the best works will be invited to Moscow in October 2017 during the All-World Festival for Youth and Students.
17. Participant applying his\her work to the Organizing Committee automatically and without any payment transfers all rights to the Organizer for public use of the applied work on the official website of the Marathon and at public events of the Marathon stating the author's name.

The Organizer has a right to use the work under his own opinion, including advertisement goals and public placement till January, 1, 2018.

18. Sending work to the Organizer, Contest participants automatically warrantee that each of them is the only author and rights holder of the work and there are no any limitations for its use. In case of complaints, claims or legal actions from the third parties, including those who have author's rights or allied rights for the sent work, Contest participant is obliged to resolve them in

his\her own name and at his\her own expense. The Organizer is not liable for the Contest participant's obligations.

19. The Organizer has a right to refuse the participant in accepting the work in case it breaks Russian or international laws, moral norms or abuses believers' feelings or in any other similar case. The Organizer is not obliged to motivate his decision to the Participant or his\her representative.

20. In case it is impossible to carry out the Contest in a way it has been planned, including reasons caused by computer viruses, faults, tampering, falsification, technical problems and any reasons that are out of Contest Organizer's control that corrupt or disturb performance, safety, honesty, integrity and due realization of the Contest, the Contest Organizer has a right under his own personal decision stop, change or temporary suspend the Contest, informing Participants about it through the official website www.fmarathon.com and using contact information of the Participant indicated in the questionnaire.
